1 WEEK - RETURN TRIP

No licence required!

Relax or get active at **Marina Wolfsbruch**. Enjoy swimming at indoor and outdoor pools, a sauna, jacuzzi or a spot of fishing before setting off. Go ashore at **Rheinsberg** and discover the castle and music academy, which offers outdoor opera festivals in the summer. Surrounded by forests, **Lychen** offers exciting green landscapes to explore by bike.

The unspoilt **Müritz Lake** is Germany's largest lake. Enjoy cycling through the stunning and varied countryside that surrounds it or indulge in a glass of wine on deck whilst looking out for some of the beautiful birds that live there. There are frequent guided tours of the medieval town of **Plau**, which is also home to a museum of sculpture.

A natural paradise

Situated in the north east of Germany, the low-lying Prussian regions of Mecklenburg and Brandenburg are a patchwork of lakes, forests and pastures. The Müritz Lake is the largest in Germany and makes up part of the Müritz National Park. This stunning spot offers you the chance to explore an exciting variety of landscapes ranging from dunes to extensive reedbeds and pine and beech forests. There are numerous hiking and cycling trails ashore and close to 150 species of bird in the area. For city lovers, cruise to Berlin and discover the magnificent historic monuments and museums. You can also visit the UNESCO world cultural heritage site of Potsdam.



1 WEEK - ONE WAY TRIP

This cruise is only possible for holders of the Permit S (sports boat) licence.

Explore the town of **Fürstenberg**, situated on three islands. Cruise to **Himmelfort** and stroll on the moorlands or take a picnic ashore to the grounds of **Oranienburg's** historic castle. Cosmopolitan **Berlin** has many attractions waiting for you. Visit the Brandenburg Gate, stroll through Tiergarten, the city's largest park, and examine the Eastside Gallery, the longest surviving section of the Berlin wall. Ramble through the pretty river setting at **Potsdam**.

Flavours of the region



Try frankfurters served with a blob of medium hot mustard and accompanied by a steaming hot dish of potato gratin with plenty of cheese, bacon and fresh vegetables or the regional favourite of carp cooked in a horseradish sauce. Follow these dishes with smooth wood smoked cheeses or spicy Lebkuchen biscuits and a glass of cold, amber beer.
